

Finger Extension Splint

Physiotherapy & Occupational Therapy

Who is this leaflet for?

This leaflet is for patients who have been given a splint called a finger extension splint (or finger stretch splint). It explains what the splint is for, how to use it and care for it, and what to do if you have any problems.

What is my splint for?

To facilitate finger extension and maintain current muscle length, to help stretch and extend your finger which in turn will reduce the chances of the muscles shortening.

How should I wear the splint?

It is important to follow your instructions. If the splint rubs, causes pain, or leaves red marks that last for more than 15 minutes, do not wear it and contact your therapist straight away.

You can wear the splint while seated or moving around.

You may require assistance to put on / take off the splint. Initially it may take time to ensure the splint is applied properly, however it will become quicker and easier with practice.

This is a self-management programme. If you do not wear your splint your current range of movement may decrease.

When should I wear the splint?

How should I look after the splint?

Wipe regularly with warm soapy water and air dry.

How should I keep my hand clean?

Make sure your hand is thoroughly washed and dried daily. Use this time to ensure the splint is not rubbing and the skin is not sore or broken. Report any break down of skin to your occupational therapist.

Please ensure finger nails are kept short with no rough edges to prevent them digging into the palm of the hand.

Will I have further appointments?

- It is important to have your splint checked at regular intervals to ensure it still fits correctly
- If your splint requires attention (i.e. it is damaged) prior to your review appointment, please let us know immediately by phoning the number you have been given
- If you cannot keep your appointment, please let us know at least 24 hours beforehand
- If you miss an appointment and do not contact us, we must recommend that you discontinue wearing the splint. We will discharge you from our department and will notify your doctor.

Remember to bring your splint with you to each appointment.
