It applies to patients attending the hospital to have their:-

- Chemotherapy treatment
- Radiotherapy treatment
- Regular blood tests to do with their treatment
- Line care.

Concessionary parking **does not** apply to patients attending purely for an outpatient appointment to see a doctor.

If you are an inpatient staying over 7 consecutive nights, your visitors can obtain a weekly Concessionary Parking Pass from our Car Parking Office (B20).

You may be able to claim "Help with travelling costs to the hospital" if you are in receipt of specific benefits. You will need a letter from the DWP and you should visit the hospital's General Office (A11) or seek advice from the Macmillan Information and Support Centre (C1).
