Introduction

This leaflet is produced for parents of children who have been referred to the Royal Wolverhampton NHS Trust Speech and Language Therapy service. It will explain what will happen when you and your child come for their first appointment. We hope you find this information useful. If you require further information prior to your child's appointment, or you are unable to attend, please telephone us on 01902 444363.

Why has my child been referred to Speech and Language Therapy?

Speech and Language Therapists work with children who are experiencing speech, language and communication difficulties. We also work with children with eating and drinking difficulties. Children are referred to the service for a number of different reasons including:

- Late talking
- Unclear speech
- Difficulties understanding what is said
- Stammering
- Voice problems
- Eating and drinking difficulties
- Social communication and interaction difficulties

You will be sent a letter asking you to phone in to book an appointment. We are usually able to offer appointments at a variety of health centres across Wolverhampton so you can choose the one that is most convenient for you. You will be given the name of the Speech and Language Therapist you will see when you book your appointment.

What will happen on my first visit?

You will be invited in to attend the session with your child. This is so that we can find out about your concerns and about your child's communication development. We may telephone you first to get some background information.

The appointment will be relaxed and informal. The therapist may use toys and pictures to find out about your child's speech and language development.

The prevention of infection is a major priority in all healthcare and everyone has a part to play.

- Please decontaminate your hands frequently for 20 seconds using soap and water or alcohol gel if available
- If you have symptoms of diarrhoea and/or vomiting, cough or other respiratory symptoms, a temperature

What happens next?

If the therapist finds that your child's speech and language skills are developing normally, they will discharge your child.

If more help is needed, this may include:

- Advice and activities for home, nursery and pre-school practise
- A course of appointments at nursery, pre-school or home
- Preschool or Nursery visits
- A follow up appointment to check progress
- Referral to other health professionals

How can I help my child?

The Speech and Language Therapist will suggest ways in which you can help your child so please talk things over with them and ask questions.

Working together with you and your child's preschool setting, we can all maximise your child's progress.
