The prevention of infection is a major priority in all healthcare and everyone has a part to play.

- Wash your hands with soap and warm water and dry thoroughly. Use hand gel, if provided, in care facilities.
- If you have symptoms of diarrhoea and vomiting stay at home and do not visit relatives that are vulnerable in hospital or in residential care. You will spread the illness.
- Keep the environment clean and safe. Let's work together to keep it that way. Prevention is better than cure.

Equipment for changing the stoma appliance:

>	Disposal bag	>	Measuring guide
>	Dry wipes	>	Template if available
>	Plain warm water	>	New stoma appliance
>	New stoma appliance	>	Bowl to empty appliance
>	Pen		if appropriate
>	Scissors	>	Reading glasses if worn

- Set out your equipment in front of the sink before removing the appliance
- Make sure the new flange is cut to size and, if drainable, the bottom of the appliance is closed
- Wash your hands
- Put some warm water into the sink
- Next, If drainable, empty your appliance into a bowl or into the toilet
- Put a few wipes on your lap under the stoma in case it works whilst the appliance is off
- Remove your appliance starting from the top and peel it downwards, then place it in the disposal bag
- Clean around your stoma with moistened wipes, then dry thoroughly
- Put on your new appliance and press firmly all round the flange
- Clear away equipment, tie up disposal bag and discard in a Clinical waste disposal whilst in hospital. Use your dustbin when you go home
- Wash your hands
