Neurological Conditions



A Neurological Condition is a condition that results from damaged peripheral nerves. Receiving a diagnosis of a Neurological condition or injury can be an unsettling and confusing time. It is therefore important that you get the right support for your needs. This can have an impact on people's lives.

Who are the Community Neurological Rehabilitation Team (C.N.R.T)?

We are a community based rehabilitation team that is made up of the following Professionals:

- Consultant in Rehabilitation Medicine
- Occupational Therapists
- Physiotherapists
- Speech and Language Therapists
- Clinical Nurse Specialists in Multiple Sclerosis and Parkinsons Disease
- Neurology Specialist nurse
- Clinical Psychologist
- Rehabilitation technicians
- Rehabilitation assistances.

What does the C.N.R.T do?

The C.N.R.T works with patients and families in their own home, as well as in wider communities. We support our patients to help them to achieve the maximum level of independence possible. We aim to work with other professionals across the NHS, Social Care and voluntary sector to ensure maximum support. During your time with our service we will signpost you to any appropriate services that can support you along your journey.

Who can refer to the C.N.R.T?

- All health and social care professionals
- Yourself (if already been seen by the team in the past).

The prevention of infection is a major priority in all healthcare and everyone has a part to play.

Referral Criteria:

- Diagnosis of a neurological condition
- Registered with a Wolverhampton or Seisdon Peninsula GP
- Aged 16 years or over.

The professional who referred you should have made you aware that they plan to refer you to our service and to have gained your consent.

What is Rehabilitation?

Rehabilitation is the process of helping you to restore skills that you have lost or now find more difficult following your diagnosis. We will work with you to help you reach your full potential with individually identified and specified goals. These goals could include the following:

- Regaining independence or adapting in activities of daily living that are important to you
- To improve/manage changes to mobility, posture and movement problems
- To improve/manage changes to swallowing and communication
- Education about your condition and associated difficulties
- Support with emotional changes
- Supportive self-management of symptoms.

Length of Involvement

We are not a time limited service. Once you have reached your potential we will discharge you from the service but you are able to self-refer back to us in the future if your situation changes.

We are a community based team and so are not always in the office to answer the phone. We do have an answer phone service available which we check regularly.
